This document provides you with key information about this investment product. It is not marketing material. The information is required by law to help you understand the nature, risks, costs, potential gains and losses of this product and to help you compare it with other products.

**You are about to purchase a product that is not simple and may be difficult to understand.**

## What is this product?

<b>Type</b>	The product is in the form of a certificate issued under English law. It is not an interest bearing security. The payment obligations of the product manufacturer are not guaranteed by any entity.
<b>Term</b>	The product has a fixed term and will be due on March 14, 2029, subject to an early redemption.
<b>Objectives</b>	The product provides the potential for capital growth and does not pay interest. What you will receive at the end of the term of the product is not certain and will depend on the performance of the ordinary shares of Deutsche Telekom AG (ISIN: DE0005557508) and QUALCOMM Incorporated (ISIN: US7475251036), listed on XETRA and NASDAQ Global Select Market, respectively (the <b>underlying assets</b> ). In addition, you will take the risk that some or all of the value of your investment may be lost at the end of the term of the product. The term of the product will end no later than March 14, 2029. However, the product may terminate early depending on the performance of the underlying assets. Each certificate has a face value of USD 1,000. The issue price is 100.00% of the face value. The product is not listed on an exchange. The subscription period is from February 17, 2025 to March 7, 2025. The issue date is March 14, 2025.

**Autocall feature:** If the closing price of each underlying asset on any autocall observation date is at or above its autocall barrier, the product will terminate on the corresponding autocall payment date. In this case, you will receive the autocall payment shown below for each certificate that you hold.

### Repayment at maturity:

This section applies only if no autocall occurs as described above.

On March 14, 2029, for each certificate that you hold:

- If the closing price of the underlying asset with the lowest performance (as compared with its initial reference price) on March 7, 2029 is at least equal to 94.00% of its initial reference price, you will receive USD 1,560.00; or
- If the closing price of any underlying asset rises to or above its star price on March 7, 2029 you will receive USD 1,000.00; or
- If the closing price of the underlying asset with the lowest performance (as compared with its initial reference price) on March 7, 2029 is at least equal to its barrier price, you will receive USD 1,000.00; or
- Otherwise*, you will receive USD 1,000.00 multiplied by (i) the closing price of the underlying asset with the lowest performance (as compared with its initial reference price) on March 7, 2029 divided by (ii) the strike price of such underlying asset.

The initial reference price of an underlying asset is the closing price of such underlying asset on March 7, 2025.

The product terms also provide that if certain exceptional events occur (1) adjustments may be made to the product and/or (2) the product issuer may terminate the product early. These events are specified in the product terms and principally relate to the

underlying assets, the product and the product manufacturer. The return (if any) you receive on such early termination is likely to be different from the scenarios described above and may be less than the amount you invested.

**Intended retail investor** The product is intended to be offered to retail investors who:

1. have the ability to make an informed investment decision through sufficient knowledge and understanding of the product and its specific risks and rewards, with experience of investing in and/or holding a number of similar products providing a similar market exposure;
2. seek capital growth, expect the movement in the underlying assets to perform in a way that generates a favourable return, have an investment horizon of the recommended holding period specified below and understand that the product may terminate early;
3. accept the risk that the issuer could fail to pay or perform its obligations under the product but otherwise are able to bear a total loss of their investment;
4. are willing to accept a level of risk to achieve potential returns that is consistent with the summary risk indicator shown below; and

## What are the risks and what could I get in return?

The risk indicator assumes you keep the product until March 14, 2029. You may not be able to cash in early. You may have to pay significant extra costs to cash in early.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 6 out of 7, which is the second-highest risk class. This takes into account two elements: (1) the market risk - that the potential losses for future performance are rated at a high level; and (2) the credit risk - that poor market conditions are deemed very unlikely to impact our capacity to pay you.

**Be aware of currency risk. You will receive payments in a different currency so the final return you will get depends on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator shown above.**

This product does not include any protection from future market performance so you could lose some or all of your investment. If we are not able to pay you what is owed, you could lose your entire investment.

The favourable, moderate, unfavourable and stress scenarios represent possible outcomes that have been calculated based on simulations using the past performance of the underlying assets over a period of up to 5 years. In the case of an early redemption, it has been assumed that no reinvestment has occurred. The stress scenario shows what you might get

back in extreme market circumstances. This product cannot be easily cashed in. If you exit the investment earlier than the recommended holding period you may have to pay extra costs.

## How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

### **Recommended holding period: 4 years**

The recommended holding period for the product is 4 years as the product is designed to be held until maturity; however the product may terminate early due to an autocall or an extraordinary event. You have no contractual right to terminate the product prior to maturity.

The manufacturer is under no obligation to make a secondary market in the product, but may repurchase the product prior to maturity on a case-by-case basis. In such circumstances, the price quoted will reflect a bid-ask spread and any costs associated with unwinding the hedging arrangements of the manufacturer in connection with the product. In addition, the person who sold you the product may charge you brokerage fees when you sell the product.
